BOARD OF DIRECTORS  
MEETING MINUTES**

AUGUST 30, 2007 – 7:30 P.M.

Call to order

The meeting was called to order at 7:42 p.m.

Directors in attendance

Miles Carroll, Rob Black, Liz Sharp-Marsden, Jeremy Krupp, Helen Zollinger, and Ryan McMurtrey established a quorum.

Visitors

Diana Molino and Peggy Sharp were in attendance.

Board business

Helen Zollinger was sworn in as a Director for the 2007-2008 school year.

Public Input

No public input was received.

**Old Business**

Staffing.

Peggy recommended that the board offer a contract to Eulalie Hall for a 6<sup>th</sup> grade science and math position. Peggy stated that Eulalie had not taught in sixteen years and that her teaching certificate had lapsed. Peggy explained that a Letter of Authorization would be required for Eulalie and she would have to take an on-line math course. If approved and she accepted the offer, Peggy was planning to have Eulalie teach two 6<sup>th</sup> grade science classes, one 6<sup>th</sup> grade math class, and one 6<sup>th</sup> grade elective. Jeremy made a motion to offer Eulalie Hall a contract. Rob seconded. Motion passed.

Peggy recommended that the board offer a contract to Greg Bramwell for a 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grade science and math position. Peggy stated that Greg had taught at two charter schools in Delaware and he moved to Idaho to re-enter his scientific field, but decided to

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return to teaching. Peggy explained that Greg would have to be on a Letter of Recommendation for math. Peggy felt that she would have to spend time in Greg's classes to ensure classroom management was satisfactory. Rob expressed concern that Peggy may have to spend an inordinate amount of time in the class. Peggy replied that she felt Greg was the best candidate available for the position. Diana stated that another candidate had scored higher on the hiring committee rubric score but neither candidate had as much experience as was desired. Liz made a motion to offer Greg Bramwell a contract. Ryan seconded. Motion passed.

Peggy recommended that the board offer a contract to Janalyn Larish as an advanced math teacher for one class per week. Ryan stated that he was abstaining from the vote on offering a contract since Janalyn is a personal friend of his, but he wanted to let the board know that she is a great person who loves to teach math. Peggy indicated that the hiring committee was not used to interview Janalyn. Helen made a motion to offer a contract to Janalyn Larish on a quarter time contract. Jeremy seconded. Motion passed with Ryan abstaining.

Adjournment

Helen motioned to adjourn. Rob seconded. Meeting adjourned at 9:00 p.m.
