OH NO!! The library currently has 101 overdue books!! Parents and students, please make note of the class library schedule and review the following library rules.

Library Rules:

Books are checked out for one week at a time, can be renewed if the student needs another week.

All library books must be returned before a student can check out a new book.

Students with outstanding overdues (more than 2 months), or more than one overdue book will lose their library privileges until ALL overdue books are returned.

If a book is lost or damaged, please contact one of the librarians. DO NOT attempt to repair a damaged book yourself. We have special materials for book repairs in the library.

As long as a student's name is on the checkout card, they are responsible for that book until it gets returned and the checkout card put back in the book.

Books are to be returned in the Book Drop slot in the library counter, unless otherwise instructed by the librarian.
