

GBB—Staff Involvement in Decision Making

Communication

The Board of Directors encourages employees to contribute their ideas for the betterment of the School. The Administrator will establish channels for the intercommunication of ideas among the professional and support staff, the administration and the Board regarding the operation of the School. In addition, the Administrator shall also weigh with due consideration the counsel given by employees. The Administrator shall inform the Board of such counsel when presenting administrative reports and recommendations for Board action. The Administrator's recommendations may vary from the advice of such counsel when, in his or her judgment, other considerations prevail.

Members of both professional and support staff may be asked to assist in developing policies, rules and procedures and establishing the School goals and objectives, budget, and curriculum.

Committees

The Administrator is authorized to establish any committees viewed as appropriate to recommend policies, rules and procedures for the proper functioning of the School, including the instructional program. Staff members should be advised, however, that the final decision on matters on which their advice is requested or received will rest with the Board or with the Administrator to whom the Board has delegated responsibility.
