

IGA—Curriculum Development

The need and value of a systematic, ongoing program of curriculum development and evaluation involving students, parents, teachers, and administrators are recognized. It is essential that the school system continually develop and modify its curriculum to meet changing needs. The Board authorizes the Administrator to develop the curriculum for the school system and to organize committees to review the curriculum. After considering committee input and data, the Administrator shall decide upon any curriculum changes and advise the Board of implementation and progress.

All personnel have professional obligations to the school program beyond regular classroom duties, and these obligations will include work on curriculum committees.
