### **LUNCH MONEY**

The Child Nutrition program uses MySchoolBucks (MSB) to track payments and student transactions. You can access this from our website or single-sign on from your PowerSchool parent portal. You can modify auto-pay options and notification settings in your MSB account. **Each meal account must be prepaid by paying in the school office or through the portal.**

### **CHARGE POLICY**

It is the parents'/guardians' responsibility to monitor the meal accounts. An account that exceeds negative \$50.00 is considered overdue. **Any accounts that exceed \$50 in charges will be sent to collections.**

### **FREE or REDUCED-PRICE MEALS**

Applications are required each year. Please fill them out as soon as possible so that there are no negative balances in your student account. Please note the charge policy.

### **END OF YEAR BALANCES / INACTIVE ACCOUNTS / GRADUATED STUDENTS**

**Active Students:** Account balances will carry over to the next year.

**Inactive Students:** Students leaving the school or graduating must request a refund. All inactive student accounts with positive balances will be transferred to the charitable account at the end of each school year.
