

BAA—Evaluation of School Board/Self-Evaluation

Internal Accountability of the Board of Directors

The Board shall meet as necessary for the purpose of appraising its functioning as a Board and to evaluate Board performance. The appraisal plan approved by the Board will be facilitated by the Board Chair working with the Administrator.

Evaluation instruments for Board operation may be used in the process.

Performance Areas of Consideration

Areas of Board operations and relationships that may be appropriate to consider during the evaluation of Board performance may include, but are not limited to:

- Board meetings/decision-making process
- Policy development/implementation
- Goal setting
- Curriculum and instruction management/program
- Fiscal management/resource allocation
- School plant planning/management
- Board member orientation
- Board member development
- Board officer performance
- Board member relationships
- Board-Administrator relationship
- Board-community relationship
- Legislative and governmental relationships
