

BBB—Board Qualifications – Elections/Appointment

Qualifications

The Board of Directors of White Pine Charter School will consist of no less than five (5) and no more than seven (7) members. At least one director shall not have children attending the School, and at least two directors shall be parents with children in attendance at the School.

A Board member shall not hold a board position in any other education-related organization.

No employee of the School shall hold membership on the Board.

Elections

Board elections shall be held annually. The Parent Faculty Association shall conduct the elections according to established by-laws.

Directors shall be elected or appointed to a three-year term of office.

Mid-Term Appointment

Any mid-term vacancy may be filled by the appointment of a qualified individual in which the appointment was established by a majority vote of the Board. Upon conclusion of the term of appointment, the Board Member shall have the choice of running for another term in accordance with the Board Member election process.

Board Officers

Officers of the Board shall be elected annually by a majority vote of the members of the Board, in an open meeting. The officers of the Board of Directors shall be:

- Board Chair
- Board Vice-Chair
- Secretary
- Treasurer

Neither the Secretary nor the Treasurer shall serve concurrently as the Board Chair or Board Vice-Chair.
