

BEDD—Rules of Order

The general rules for Board meetings are as follows:

- It shall hold a regular meeting at least once each month during the regular school year and may hold other meetings as often as called.
- Each action item shall require a motion, and all motions shall require seconding.
- The Chair may make or second motions, and may vote on all motions.
- A motion to adjourn is in order at any time. Such a motion shall require a second and a majority vote. No discussion is in order.
- A motion to table is in order at any time. Such a motion requires a second and is limited to being considered only once on any given agenda item. No discussion is in order.
- Rules of order may be subject to suspension only upon a majority vote of the members of the Board Chair at a meeting.

The Board Chair retains the right to conduct all meetings under Robert's Rules of Order. A Parliamentarian may be appointed by the Board Chair from among non-Officer members of the Board. Notwithstanding, the final resolution of any matter pertaining to rules of order, rests with the Board Chair.
