

EEAA—Walkers and Riders

This policy does not apply for those students assigned transportation as part of their Individualized Education Plan (I.E.P.). Nothing in this policy is intended to limit the Board's authority in the future to eliminate furnishing transportation to students as may be permitted by law. In the event of any dispute over the proper application of this policy, the Board's decision shall be final.

Carpool

The Administrator shall develop carpool plans that minimize traffic impact upon the local neighborhood while maximizing student safety.

Bus Transportation

The Board authorizes the administration to provide regular, contracted school bus transportation to and from school. The School and all contractors who provide transportation services to the School shall comply with applicable provisions of the Commercial Motor Vehicle Safety Act of 1986 and all applicable requirements of the state of Idaho that pertain to vehicle standards, periodic inspection, and maintenance of school buses.

The school shall provide students with disabilities who require transportation, as indicated in their respective individual education programs.

Transportation for homeless students will be arranged as needed.

Bus Transportation Zones

The Administrator shall establish procedures for the development, establishment, and annual evaluation of bus routes.
