Student Safety

The safety and welfare of student riders is to be the first consideration in all matters pertaining to transportation. Toward that end, all School contracted bussing services shall comply with the applicable federal and state regulations

Any violation of rules or state statutes that threatens the safety of a passenger shall constitute grounds for contract nullification.

Bus evacuation drills shall be conducted at least once every school year at the school and shall include all students who are in school on the day of the evacuation drill.

Student Drop Offs

Students shall not be put off the bus until reaching their destination.

Vehicle Safety Act

Each school bus owned by, or contracted to, the School will conform to all applicable federal and state requirements as provided by the Commercial Motor Vehicle Safety Act of 1986.

Each driver of a School-owned or School-contracted school bus, as defined by and covered by the Commercial Motor Vehicle Safety Act of 1986, will conform to all requirements of said act and such statutes as may govern the operation of the vehicle.
