EF—Food Services

The School may operate a school food service program. Food services will include lunches, and may include breakfasts, through participation in the National School Lunch Program.

The Board will approve the prices set for school meals.

As required for participation in the National School Lunch Program, the Board prescribes:

- That a school lunch be made available to students.
- That free and reduced-price lunch be provided students who qualify under federal guidelines.
- Students will also be permitted to bring their lunches from home and to purchase beverages.

The Administrator shall develop and implement procedures as necessary, which are designed to meet the necessary requirements for participation in the National School Lunch Program and for control of students using the cafeteria.
