

EFH—Food Service Sanitation Program

School food service programs must meet all sanitary regulations recommended by the State Department of Health for food-handling establishments and the respective county or federal inspection agency.

Cleanliness and sanitation should be an integral part of food production, and shall receive the proper emphasis to ensure that standards are high.

Food Handlers Cards

All Student Nutrition Services staff are required to have a current Food Handlers card issued by the State. A copy of the card is to be on file in the School office and posted in the kitchen where the staff member is working. Substitute staff must have a current card on file in the School office and have the original with them while working. It is the staff members' responsibility to keep their cards current.
