

GBEBC—Gifts to and Solicitations by Staff

Professional Integrity

A professional educator maintains integrity with students, colleagues, parents, patrons, or business personnel when accepting gifts, gratuities, favors, and additional compensation. Unethical conduct includes, but is not limited to:

- Unauthorized soliciting of students and/or parents of students to purchase equipment or supplies from the educator who will directly benefit;
- Accepting gifts from vendors or potential vendors for personal use or gain where there may be the appearance of a conflict of interest;
- Tutoring students assigned to the educator for remuneration unless approved by the Board; and,
- Soliciting, accepting or receiving a pecuniary benefit greater than fifty (\$50.00) dollars as defined in Idaho Code §18-1359(b).
