

JEB—Entrance Age Requirements

For a child enrolling in the first grade, the age of six (6) years must be reached on or before September 1st of the school year in which the child is to enroll. Any child of the age of five (5) years who has completed a private or public out-of-state kindergarten for the required four hundred fifty (450) hours but has not reached the "school age" requirement in Idaho shall be allowed to enter the first grade.

For resident children with disabilities who qualify for special education and related services under the federal Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) and applicable state and federal regulations, "school age" shall begin at the attainment of age three (3).

A legal birth certificate or other acceptable records shall be required for enrollment age certification.
