Required to Attend School

Students with children are required to attend school under state attendance laws.

The Administrator may grant an attendance waiver to a student who has a child if he/she determines that suitable day care is unavailable. The student must consult with the Administrator, or designee, in a timely manner to consider all available day care options or the School will consider the student to be in violation of the compulsory attendance law. That law provides penalties for non-attendance.
