JJJ—Extracurricular Activity Eligibility

Policy Intent

Participation in athletics and extracurricular activities is considered a privilege, not a right, and students wishing to participate are required to meet standards of personal behavior and academic performance. Although participation in extracurricular activities and athletics is a valued complement to its educational goals, White Pine Charter School recognizes that the academic program must have top priority in the educational process.

Definition

For purposes of this policy, "activity" means any extracurricular or interscholastic activity including but not limited to any academic, artistic, athletic, recreational or other related activity offered by the School. Examples of such activities include but are not limited to interscholastic sports, music, or student council. "Activity" does not include school dances or other similar after-school events.

For purposes of this policy, "failing grade" means that the student has a grade of "F."

For purposes of this policy, "an incomplete" means that the student has a grade of "I."

Eligibility

Students must maintain a 2.0 GPA in order to retain eligibility for participation. Students who have a failing grade or an incomplete shall not participate in the extracurricular activity until such grade is raised to a non-failing/or incomplete status changed.
