

KFAA—Tobacco Use on School Premises at Public Functions

The use of tobacco products is prohibited in the following locations:

- School grounds.
- School building.
- School parking lot.
- School playing field.
- School buses and other School vehicles.
- Off-campus school-sponsored events.

The prohibitions do not apply to an adult when possession or use of the tobacco products are for demonstration purposes as a necessary instructional component of a tobacco prevention or cessation program that is approved by the school.

All entrances to the building will be posted with a notice that these facilities are tobacco-free.

All School employees are expected to cooperate in the enforcement of this policy. A verbal warning should be given. If there is a second violation, the Administrator must be notified for appropriate corrective action.

Members of the public using or blatantly flaunting tobacco or tobacco products on school premises shall be requested to leave the premises in according with laws on trespassing.
